

2006 IT TAG Minutes
October 24, 2005

The 2006 Information Technology TAG convened at 8:09 a.m. Tuesday October 24, 2006.

The 2005 IT TAG meeting was attended by four current members and several proxies for current members. We think we had a total of 50 attendees because that is how many people signed the attendance sheet.

The existing mission statement, short range goals, and long range goals were reviewed and accepted as written.

The TAG reviewed TMRs 9150, 6912, 7155, 7505, 9569, 9570, and 3651.

The TAG unanimously endorsed the following TMRs as written: 9150, 6912, 7155, 9569, and 9570.

The TAG voted to add a comment to TMR 7505. The comment is “The 2006 IT TAG endorses the agency-configurable option for international currencies for inclusion in the NGT suite of products. The IT TAG will take no action on TMR 7505 for client/server modules”.

The TAG voted to add a comment to TMR 3651. “Because of the unified data model for NGT, archive and restore becomes obsolete for PES/LAS (pre-construction modules), because the project records will be needed for DSS and the Construction modules. Data will also need to remain on the active database as long as it would be needed for research in DSS (this could be forever or to whatever length of time that the data is still relevant to be on the live database). We continue to support archive and restore but realize that it would only be applicable after the data is no longer of relevant value to DSS”.
