Enhancement TMR's:

#### Discussion regarding enhancement TMR's and the balloting process

- What's the point of voting if none of the TMR's will be incorporated into future releases of SiteManager?
  - Voting shows the TTF what issues are important and will get priority in the development of NGT
- There needs to be a better sharing of knowledge between states. Some states have work-arounds for TMR's and the other states are not aware. There seems to be interest in holding a round-table discussion at the next TUG Conference (or possibly sooner) to discuss the technical issues and share knowledge. It was also mentioned that posting comments to the TMR's would be a good way to share knowledge.
- There is also concern that the states' opinions on the direction of NGT will be too diversified. A JAD needs to be held to ensure that all states are on the same page. An informal round-table discussion or teleconference may be necessary prior to the JAD session.
- There needs to be a better way for determining which enhancement TMR's are the most important to all states. A modification to the balloting process may be necessary.
- Jeremy Kampeter will follow up with Jim Johnson on putting together a JAD session.
- Ballot voting will occur November 6 through 17. The final day to submit pre-ballot TMR's is November 1.
